NDCPD's *ND Vocational Rehabilitation Expanded Supported Employment* project builds capacity to deliver supported employment services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities that lead to integrated and competitive employment opportunities for those currently receiving day support and segregated employment services. Vocational Rehabilitation funded NDCPD to initiate and oversee training and technical assistance for four pilot sites to utilize employment first, best practices. Project staff have worked with four community based organizations that have implemented the "Expanded Supported Employment" project.
